SUMMARY OF BILL: Removes the condition prohibiting an individual, required to register pursuant to the Tennessee Sexual Offender and Violent Sexual Offender Registration, Verification, and Tracking Act of 2004 (SORA), who has been convicted of a sexual offense or violent sexual offense in which the victim was a child under the age of 12 from residing, conducting an overnight visit, or being alone with his or her child.
