SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a person holding a class license as an amateur radio operator to display flashing white or amber lights on their vehicle when actively responding to a person in distress if the vehicle displays an amateur radio license plate.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-9-402(d), various exceptions are made to the prohibition of vehicles being equipped with any flashing lights in any color or combination of colors, including but not limited to private security services, highway maintenance, organ procurement organizations, and motorcycle escorts of funeral processions.
- Permitting licensed amateur radio operators with specific license plates to display flashing white or amber lights on their vehicle when actively responding to a person in distress will not result in a significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
