FISCAL NOTE

SB 1657 – HB 1846

January 17, 2024

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Department of Health (DOH) to submit an annual report to the Governor, detailing the total number of firearm injuries and deaths, as well as certain demographics, caused by firearms in this state per 100,000 people that occurred in the previous calendar year. Requires the Attorney General and Reporter to assist in collecting information necessary for the reports, upon request.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Much of the required information is currently published by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's National Center for Health Statistics. The DOH can compile and submit the required reports utilizing existing personnel and resources; therefore, any fiscal impact will be not significant.
