**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 1910 - HB 2023**

January 30, 2022

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires a landlord or person in control of a residential rental property to report to an investigator from the Department of Children's Services (DCS) or a child protective investigation team any known information regarding the address or location of a child who has been alleged to be abused or neglected if the child resides or is located on the residential rental property. Provides exemption from civil and criminal liability for such persons.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation will have no effect on the policies and procedures of the DCS; therefore, the fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- Exempting a landlord or person in control of a residential rental property from liability in any civil or criminal action, except in cases of willful and wanton conduct or intentional wrongdoing, is not expected to fiscally impact the court system.
