SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Department of Education (DOE) to report for each local education agency (LEA) for each school year, the number of appeals filed with the department for a student identified for retention in third grade based on the student's achieving a performance level rating of approaching on the English language arts portion of the student's most recent Tennessee Comprehensive Assessment Program test to the education committees of the Senate and the House of Representatives by December 1, 2024, and each subsequent December 1.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-3115(e), the DOE is required to report information related to third grade promotion and retention.
- The DOE will be able to include appeals information in the required annual reporting related to third grade promotion and retention within existing resources and during the normal course of business such that any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
