SUMMARY OF BILL: Adds local law enforcement officials to the list of individuals who must be appointed to each district-wide school safety team. Specifies that each district-wide school safety team shall annually review the respective district-wide or building-level school safety plan.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Tennessee Code Annotated § 49-6-806(a) requires a district's director of schools to appoint certain individuals to each district-wide school safety team.
- A director of schools will be able to make additional appointments within existing resources and during the normal course of business such that any increase in local expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
- Law enforcement officials will be able to serve on a district-wide school safety team in a capacity such that any fiscal impact to local law enforcement agencies is estimated to be not significant.
- Tennessee Code Annotated § 49-6-804(a) requires each LEA and public charter school to review school safety plans annually.
- Requiring each safety team to instead review their respective safety plans annually will not result in any significant impact to local operations.
