SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits a state or local contractor or grantee, during the period between contract execution or award of a grant through the completion of the contract or grant period, from directly or indirectly promising or making a contribution to a political campaign committee, candidate, or person for political purpose, or from knowingly soliciting a contribution from any person on behalf of a political campaign committee, candidate, or person for a political purpose.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation is not expected to have a significant impact on the process of awarding or executing state or local government contracts or the final outcomes of such contracts.
- Any impact on contributions to a political campaign committee, candidate, or person for
 political purpose as a result of the proposed legislation will be borne by private parties;
 any impact on state or local revenue is estimated to be not significant.
