SB 2514 - HB 2643

February 5, 2024

SUMMARY OF BILL: Adds the title *The Gabby Act* to Public Chapter (PC) 237 of 2023, which requires each District Attorneys General to designate at least one Assistant District Attorneys General (ADAG) currently employed within the judicial district as the lead prosecutor in cases involving crimes committed against children and requires the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, District Attorneys General Conference (DAGC), and other relevant parties at the request of the DAGC to work in conjunction to provide annual training to ADAGs or other appropriate staff members in the prosecution of crimes committed against children.
