**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 1975 – SB 2565**

February 3, 2022

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Exempts the Doe Mountain Recreation Authority (Authority) from the requirement to promulgate rules to establish and impose user fees.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Based on information from the Authority, it does not currently receive funding from state government, but relies on user fees, sales of carbon credits, and grants to support its operations.
- The Authority has not increased its fees since its inception, approximately 10 years ago.
- This legislation will allow the Authority to raise its fees without having to promulgate rules, to aid the Authority in being financially solvent.
- This legislation is estimated to have no significant impact on state or local government.
