HB 2496 - SB 2597

February 27, 2018

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits restraining any inmate engaged in work within or outside of a prison, jail, or workhouse facility in a manner that joins the inmate with one or more other inmates.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Title 41, Chapter 21, Part 2 of the Tennessee Code Annotated provides for regulations for the care of inmates in the state's custody.
- The proposed legislation would prohibit the restraint of any inmate to another inmate while engaged in work within or outside of any prison, jail or workhouse facility.
- There will be no fiscal impact on the Department of Correction.
