SUMMARY OF BILL AS AMENDED (013435): Requires an internet service provider that utilizes carrier-grade NAT technology to retain user log data for a period of at least one year. Requires an internet service provider to make the user log data available to a law enforcement officer, district attorneys or a district attorney's designee, or the Attorney General or the Attorney General's designee upon request to obtain disclosure of stored wire or electronic communications and related transactional records.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL AS AMENDED:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- The proposed legislation defines carrier-grade NAT technology as technology in which an internet service provider assigns a subscriber a dynamic or fixed temporary private network address so that multiple subscribers may access the internet through one or more shared public internet protocol addresses.
- Passage of the proposed legislation will have no significant impact on state or local government operations.
