FISCAL NOTE

HB 2256 - SB 2685

February 12, 2024

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from 45 to 60, the number of days, following a petition for judicial review by a tenured faculty member seeking review for dismissal or suspension, that the Board of Regents or the state university board has to transmit to the court an original or certified copy of the entire record of the dismissal or suspension proceeding.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The increased timeline for submitting documents will not impact the court system or impair a tenured faculty member's right to judicial review.
- The Board of Regents or the state university board will be able to comply with the proposed legislation with existing resources and during the normal course of business.
- Any fiscal impact to state government is estimated to be not significant.
