FISCAL NOTE

HB 2866 - SB 2688

March 14, 2024

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (DMHSAS) to conduct a study on the effectiveness of state programs incentivizing students to pursue careers in mental healthcare, including an analysis of similar programs that are in use or may have been used in contiguous states.

Requires DMHSAS to submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the Chair of the Health and Welfare Committee of the Senate, the Health Committee of the House of Representatives, and the Legislative Librarian by December 31, 2024.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The DMHSAS can conduct the required study and submit a report utilizing existing personnel and resources, without an increase in expenditures.
- Any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
