FISCAL NOTE

HB 2508 - SB 2774

March 9, 2024

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Department of Human Services (DHS) to provide the Department of Safety (DOS) with written or electronic data exchange confirmation that an obligor whose commercial driver license was suspended or revoked due solely to noncompliance with an order of support is currently in reasonable compliance if the obligor shows they are employed in a position requiring a commercial driver license and that the employment will result in the compliance of child support payments. Requires DOS to reinstate the license upon receipt of the confirmation of reasonable compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- DHS will be able to provide written or electronic data exchange confirmation to DOS by utilizing existing resources and personnel, and therefore without any significant increase in state expenditures.
- Any increase in child support as a result of the proposed legislation will go towards private citizens, and therefore will not result in an increase in state revenue.
- Any impact on state revenue associated with reinstatement of commercial driver licenses is estimated to be not significant.
