HB 2872 - SB 2805

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a local education agency (LEA) to offer an adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) training program partially or wholly online.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-1-230(c), an LEA may develop its own ACEs training program to make available to the LEA's school personnel.
- The proposed legislation authorizes LEAs to offer ACEs training partially or wholly online.
- If an LEA chooses to administer a portion or the entirety of its ACEs training program online, then it will be able to do so within existing resources.
- No significant impact to the Department of Education.
