SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a court to waive the court costs for a petition to restore a person's rights.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Decrease Local Revenue – \$13,000/FY24-25 and Subsequent Years/Permissive

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 8-21-401(b)(1)(D)(iv), a court clerk shall charge a standard court cost of \$100 at the institution of a case of restoration of citizenship.
- Each county may charge additional fees, which vary widely. For the purposes of this analysis, it is assumed the average total cost for a petition is \$175.
- To the extent a court waives the court costs, there will be a permissive decrease in local revenue of \$175 per case.
- There has been an approximate average of 740 successful restoration of rights in Tennessee each year.
- It is assumed that a court will waive court costs of at least 10 percent of these successful petitions, resulting in at least 74 (740 x 10%) waivers each year.
- The proposed legislation will result in a permissive, recurring decrease in local revenue of \$12,950 (74 x \$175).
