HOUSE BILL 30

AN ACT to name a bridge on State Route 36 in the City of Kingsport in memory of Michael K. Locke.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE: SECTION 1.

- (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the bridge (No. 82SR0360005) on State Route 36 (Ft. Henry Drive) at log mile 4.45 in the City of Kingsport is hereby designated the "Michael K. Locke Memorial Bridge" to honor a dedicated public servant who proudly served the people of Kingsport in several capacities, including as a member of the Tennessee House of Representatives during the 102nd General Assembly.
- (b) The department of transportation is directed to erect suitable signs or to affix suitable markers designating the bridge described in subsection (a) as the "Michael K. Locke Memorial Bridge."
- (c) The erection of the signs shall be within the guidelines prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and within the state supplemental guidelines, as applicable.
- (d) This act shall become operative only if the cost of the manufacture and installation of the signs is paid to the department of transportation from nonstate funds within one (1) year of the effective date of this act. The payment shall be made prior to any expenditure by the state for the manufacture or installation of the signs. The department shall return any unused portion of the estimated cost to the person or entity paying for the signs within thirty (30) days of the erection of the signs. If the actual cost exceeds the estimated cost, an amount equal to the difference in the costs shall be

remitted to the department in nonstate funds within thirty (30) days of the sponsoring person or entity receiving an itemized invoice of the actual cost from the department.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
