AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-14-146, relative to retail theft.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-14-146(a), shall be amended by adding the following language as new subdivisions:
 - (6) Removes, destroys, deactivates, or evades any component of an antishoplifting or inventory control device to commit or facilitate a theft;
 - (7) Uses any artifice, instrument, container, device, or other article to commit or facilitate a theft; or
 - (8) Activates or interferes with a fire alarm system to commit or facilitate a theft.
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-14-146, is amended by adding the following language as a new subsection:
 - (c) Notwithstanding any other law, a fifth or subsequent conviction in a two-year period shall be punished one (1) classification higher than provided by § 39-14-105, and subject to a fine of not less than three hundred dollars (\$300) nor more than the maximum fine established for the appropriate offense classification.
 - SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017, the public welfare requiring it.
