AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 29, Part 2 and Title 9, Chapter 4, Part 6, relative to the Tennessee interagency cash flow committee.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-238(a), is amended by deleting subdivision (53).
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-244(a), is amended by inserting the following as a new subdivision:
 - () Tennessee interagency cash flow committee, created by § 9-4-610;
- SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 9-4-610, is amended by deleting subsection (b) and substituting instead the following:
 - (b)(1) The committee shall consist of six (6) members as follows:
 - (A) The state treasurer, or the state treasurer's designee;
 - (B) One (1) staff person with the department of the treasury, designated by the state treasurer;
 - (C) The comptroller of the treasury, or the comptroller's designee;
 - (D) One (1) staff person with the comptroller of the treasury, designated by the comptroller;
 - (E) The commissioner of finance and administration, or a staff person with the department of finance and administration, designated by the commissioner of finance and administration as the commissioner's designee; and
 - (F) The commissioner of revenue, or a staff person with the department of revenue, designated by the commissioner of revenue as the commissioner's designee.
 - (2) The state treasurer, or the state treasurer's designee, shall serve as chair of the committee.
 - (3) All members of the committee serve at the will and pleasure of the authority designating such member.
- SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 9-4-610, is further amended by deleting subsection (c) and substituting instead the following:
 - (c) The committee shall meet at the call of the state treasurer. The presence of a majority of the membership of the committee shall constitute a quorum. All actions of the

committee shall be adopted upon a majority vote of the members of the committee who are participating in a meeting.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
