AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-315, relative to criminal offenses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-315(d)(1), is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision (C):

Commits the offense of stalking or aggravated stalking, the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older, and the victim of the offense was less than twelve (12) years of age at any time during the person's course of conduct.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


