## **HOUSE BILL 304**

## By Camper

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 4; Title 67 and Title 71, relative to opioid overdoses.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 4, Part 2, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

- (a) As a condition of receiving or renewing a license under this chapter for the consumption of alcoholic beverages on the premises, each applicant for a new or renewed license shall provide proof satisfactory to the commission that the establishment maintains at least one (1) unexpired four-milligram (4 mg) dose of the opiate antagonist naloxone hydrochloride suspended in a one-tenth-milliliter (0.1 mL) nasal spray in an easily accessible location on the premises.
- (b) This section only applies to establishments that have gross sales of alcoholic beverages of more than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) per calendar year.
  SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
