

HOUSE BILL 385

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4;
Title 8 and Title 56, relative to autism.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The commissioner of commerce and insurance shall conduct a study for the purpose of determining the amount of insurance policies that provide benefits for neurological disorders in this state. The study must also include the amount of claims for treatment of autism spectrum disorder within the insurance policies that provide benefits for neurological disorders in this state. The commissioner shall submit a copy of the report to the insurance committee of the house of representatives and the commerce and labor committee of the senate no later than January 1, 2020.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
