### **PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 328**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-2-702 and Title 49, Chapter 4, Part 9, relative to synchronization of ACT and SAT scores.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-4-907(3)(B), is amended by deleting the language "a combined SAT score of at least 980" and substituting instead "a concordant equivalent score on the SAT".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-4-908, is amended by deleting the language "a combined SAT score of at least 980" wherever it appears and substituting instead "a concordant equivalent score on the SAT".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-4-916, is amended by deleting the language "a combined SAT score of at least 1280" wherever it appears and substituting instead "a concordant equivalent score on the SAT".

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-4-920(a)(6), is amended by deleting the language "a combined SAT score of at least 860" and substituting instead "a concordant equivalent score on the SAT".

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-4-930(d)(3), is amended by deleting the language "the combined SAT score" and substituting instead "the concordant equivalent score on the SAT".

SECTION 6. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-4-935(a)(3), is amended by deleting the language "a combined SAT score of at least 980" and substituting instead "a concordant equivalent score on the SAT".

SECTION 7. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-2-702(a)(2)(B), is amended by deleting the language "an average student SAT score of 980 or higher" and substituting instead "the concordant equivalent score on the SAT or a higher score".

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. SECTIONS 1 through 6 shall apply to students seeking postsecondary financial assistance from net lottery proceeds for the 2017-2018 academic years and academic years thereafter.
