## **HOUSE BILL 539**

## By Jernigan

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 63 and Title 68, relative to cytomegalovirus.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 68, Chapter 5, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section to be appropriately designated:

- (a) As used in this section, "CMV" means cytomegalovirus.
- (b) A healthcare provider, as defined by § 63-6-703, who assumes responsibility for the prenatal care of pregnant women during gestation or women who may become pregnant, shall inform those women regarding:
  - (1) The incidence of CMV;
  - (2) The transmission of CMV to pregnant women and women who may become pregnant;
    - (3) Birth defects caused by congenital CMV;
    - (4) Methods of diagnosing congenital CMV; and
    - (5) Available preventative measures.
- (c) If a newborn infant fails the newborn hearing screening pursuant to § 68-5-903, a healthcare provider shall:
  - (1) Test the newborn for CMV before the newborn is twenty-one (21) days of age, unless a parent of the newborn infant objects; and
    - (2) Provide to the parents of the newborn infant information regarding:
      - (A) Birth defects caused by congenital CMV; and
      - (B) Available methods of treatment.

(d)

- (1) Nothing in this section shall be construed to create or impose liability for failing to comply with the requirements of this section.
- (2) Nothing in this section shall be deemed to create a duty of care or other legal obligation beyond the duty to provide notice as set forth in this section.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-5-903, is amended by adding the following language at the end of the section:

A newborn who fails the screening shall be referred for screening in accordance with Section 1 of this act.

SECTION 3. This section shall become effective July 1, 2015, the public welfare requiring it.
