AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 15, Chapter 2, relative to days of special observance.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 15, Chapter 2, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

The first Monday of October of each year shall be observed as "Tennessee Rural Mayor's Day" to be proclaimed as such by the governor, to honor and recognize mayors of small cities in this state for their tireless work and dedicated service to their respective communities. This day shall not be a legal holiday as defined in § 15-1-101.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
