HOUSE BILL 625

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 19, relative to campaign advertising.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-19-144, is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and adding the following as a new subsection (b):

- (1) A political advertisement of a candidate who is not an incumbent of the office for which the candidate is running shall not include the word "re-elect," and shall include the word "for" between the candidate's name and the office for which the candidate is running, in order that incumbency is not implied.
- (2) A political advertisement of a candidate running for an office that is designated with a number or letter must include the number or letter of the district, ward, or seat for which the candidate is running.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
