AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 37, Chapter 5, Part 5, relative to child care agencies.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 37-5-501(b)(15), is amended by deleting the subdivision and substituting instead:

(15) "Nontraditional child care agency":

- (A) Means a child care agency that provides residential child care for one (1) or more children that must be transported across state lines to enter or leave the agency's care and whose transport across state lines is not subject to the Interstate Compact on Juveniles, compiled in chapter 4, part 1 of this title or the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children, compiled in chapter 4, part 2 of this title; and
- (B) Does not include a person or entity that places children in family boarding homes or foster homes;

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
