

HOUSE BILL 825

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 12,
relative to certain state properties.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The state of Tennessee shall have no more than two (2) state-owned airplanes. All other state-owned airplanes shall be considered surplus property and shall be sold or disposed of as provided by title 12, chapter 2, part 4. The sales of such state-owned airplanes shall be economically feasible, fiscally sound, and in an administratively practical manner. All revenues derived from the sale of a state-owned airplane shall be placed in the general fund. The governor shall determine the two (2) state-owned airplanes that shall be available for official use for carrying out the duties of state government.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
