AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, relative to elections.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-6-105, is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and by adding the following new subsection (b):

(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), a person convicted of voter fraud in any state shall not assist a person in voting under this section.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-6-106, is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and by adding the following new subsection (b):

(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), a person convicted of voter fraud in any state shall not assist a person in voting under this section.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 6, Part 2, is amended by adding the following new section:

Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, a person convicted of voter fraud in any state shall not assist a person in voting by absentee ballot.

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-7-116, is amended by adding the following new subsection (d):


(d) Notwithstanding this section or any other law to the contrary, a person convicted of voter fraud in any state shall not assist a person in casting a vote.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
