## **HOUSE BILL 958**

## By Clemmons

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 43 and Title 67, Chapter 6, relative to agriculture.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-6-207(a), is amended by adding the following as new subdivisions:

- () Any equipment and technology purchased for:
  - (A) Soil testing;
  - (B) Soil carbon sequestration;
- (C) The implementation of regenerative farming practices, including, but not limited to, compost application, mulching, no-till, and conservation tillage and cover cropping;
  - (D) Organic farming;
- (E) Conservation farming practices, including, but not limited to, direct seeding, field windbreaks, rotational grazing, perennial forage crops, reduced summer fallow, and proper straw management; or
  - (F) Reforestation;
- () Tree seedlings;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 43, Chapter 1, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

Minimum acreage requirements for eligibility for cost-share grants associated with the row crop solutions portion of the department's Tennessee agricultural enhancement program are as follows:

(1) One hundred (100) acres of land in row crop production; or

- (2) Fifty (50) acres of land in row crop production if the applicant for the program's cost-share grant engages in:
  - (A) Soil carbon sequestration;
  - (B) Regenerative farming practices, including, but not limited to, compost application, mulching, no-till, or conservation tillage and cover cropping;
    - (C) Organic farming; or
    - (D) Other conservation farming practices.

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
