## **HOUSE BILL 995**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40, Chapter 32, Part 1, relative to the expunction of certain criminal records.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-32-101, is amended by deleting subdivision (g)(2)(B) and substituting:

(B)

- (i) At the time of the filing of the petition for expunction of a felony offense at least five (5) years have elapsed since the completion of the sentence imposed for the felony offense; or
- (ii) At the time of the filing of the petition for expunction of a misdemeanor offense at least three (3) years have elapsed since the completion of the sentence imposed for the misdemeanor offense;

SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2021, the public welfare requiring it.
