## **HOUSE BILL 1069**

## By Hemmer

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, relative to voters.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-2-116, is amended by deleting the language:

- 5. Social Security number, if any and substituting instead:
  - 5. The last four (4) digits of Social Security number, if any
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-6-202(a)(3), is amended by deleting subdivision (D) and substituting instead the following:
  - (D) The last four (4) digits of the voter's social security number;

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-6-502(b), is amended by deleting the language "social security number" and substituting instead "the last four (4) digits of the voter's social security number".

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-7-112(a)(2), is amended by deleting the language "social security number or voter identification number" and substituting instead "voter identification number or the last four (4) digits of the voter's social security number".

SECTION 5. Existing supplies of applications, forms, and documents to which this act applies may be exhausted before a county election commission or the secretary of state creates new applications, forms, and documents that comply with this act.

SECTION 6. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
