HOUSE BILL 1168

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, relative to financial literacy.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 6, Part 17, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

(a) The Tennessee financial literacy commission shall annually host a financial literacy webinar for students in each of the grades six through eight (6-8). The financial literacy webinar must be age and grade appropriate and designed to educate students on budgeting, saving, spending, credit, debit, insurance, investment, and other topics and concepts associated with personal financial responsibility, as determined by the commission and approved by the department of education.

(b) Each LEA and public charter school shall require students enrolled in the LEA or public charter school in any of the grades six through eight (6-8) to participate in the financial literacy webinar hosted by the commission.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2023, the public welfare requiring it, and applies to the 2023-2024 school year and each school year thereafter.
