AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 38; Title 41 and Title 68, relative to medical care.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 38, Chapter 8, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

- (a) The Tennessee peace officer standards and training (POST) commission shall adopt guidelines and materials instructing law enforcement officers on the best practices for recognizing and responding to a medical crisis involving a person under arrest or under the care or supervision of the law enforcement officer.
- (b) The guidelines and materials must not require an officer to undergo specialized medical training for the purposes of becoming POST certified.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
