HOUSE BILL 1261

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57,
relative to beverages containing a certain
percentage of alcohol.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-5-105(g)(1), is amended by deleting the second sentence and by substituting instead the following language:

Such a temporary license or permit shall not allow the sale, storage or manufacture of beer on publicly owned property; provided that such prohibition shall not apply to an event that is sanctioned by a municipal or county government to be held in conjunction with a fair or on publicly owned municipal parks, streets or sidewalks where the event is held within the municipality and the streets are cordoned off to permit only foot traffic.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
