HOUSE BILL 1573

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39; Title 40 and Title 55, relative to law enforcement encounters.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE: SECTION 1.

- (a) The peace officer standards and training (POST) commission shall study and make recommendations on how vehicle drivers and passengers should behave when stopped by a police officer. The recommendations must include, but are not limited to, best practices for:
 - (1) How a driver or passenger should address a police officer;
 - (2) How a driver or passenger should use their hands, including whether or not a driver or passenger should reach for anything prior to being told to do so by a police officer; and
 - (3) Safe places to pull over a vehicle.
- (b) The POST commission shall provide the recommendations required by subsection (a) to the department of safety by December 1, 2020.
 - (c) The department of safety shall:
 - (1) Include the recommendations received pursuant to subsection (b) in the Tennessee Comprehensive Driver License Manual printed in 2021 and each Tennessee Comprehensive Driver License Manual printed thereafter; and
 - (2) Make the recommendations received pursuant to subsection (b) available on the department of safety's website.

	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring
it.
