AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4; Title 7; Title 8; Title 46; Title 47; Title 48; Title 50; Title 56; Title 62; Title 63 and Title 68, relative to the regulation of commerce.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-3-124(a), is amended by deleting the subsection in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(a) The board shall issue a certificate of registration as a barber instructor to a

person who:

(1) Files an application with the board in the form that the board may prescribe, accompanied by the examination fee required by § 62-3-129;

(2) Holds a valid certificate of registration as a master barber and has been duly registered as a master barber for a period of at least three (3) years;

(3) Has completed the twelfth (12th) grade in an accredited school or the equivalent;

(4) Holds a valid certificate of registration as a master barber and has completed a four hundred fifty-hour instructor training program at a boardcertified barber school; and

(5) Successfully completes an examination prescribed by the board.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, the public welfare requiring it.
