AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 7, Chapter 86, Part 2, relative to emergency communication personnel requirements.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:


SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-86-205, is amended by deleting subdivision (d)(7) and substituting:

(7) Have passed a physical examination by a licensed physician, or a nurse practitioner or physician assistant, so long as the task is expressly included in the written protocol developed jointly by the supervising physician and the nurse practitioner or physician assistant, whichever is applicable, setting forth the range of services that may be performed by the nurse practitioner or physician assistant; and

SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2024, the public welfare requiring it.
