AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 29 and Title 4, Chapter 56, relative to the advisory council on state procurement.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-241(a), is amended by deleting subdivision (2).

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-245(a), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:

() Advisory council on state procurement, created by § 4-56-106;

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-56-106(b), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:

(4)

(A) Any voting member who misses more than fifty percent (50%) of the scheduled meetings in a calendar year is removed as a member of the council.

(B) The presiding officer of the council shall promptly notify, or cause to be notified, the appointing authority of any voting member who fails to satisfy the attendance requirement as prescribed in subdivision (b)(4)(A).

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
