## **PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 830**

### **SENATE BILL NO. 1706**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, relative to county election commissions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 12, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

(a) If an administrator of elections attends a training, seminar, conference, or other educational event related to elections and such event is outside of this state, the administrator of elections must file a form prescribed by the coordinator of elections reporting, at a minimum, the following information:

- (1) The name of the event and the entity hosting or producing the event;
- (2) The location and date of the event;
- (3) The identity of the person or entity that paid for the attendance of the administrator of elections;
- (4) Number of days attended; and
- (5) The total amount of county, state, or federal funds used to attend the event, if any.

(b) The administrator of elections shall file the form with the state election commission no later than fifteen (15) days after the date of the out-of-state training, seminar, conference, or other educational event related to elections.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
