

## **PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 830**

#### **SENATE BILL NO. 1706**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, relative to county election commissions.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 12, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

- (a) If an administrator of elections attends a training, seminar, conference, or other educational event related to elections and such event is outside of this state, the administrator of elections must file a form prescribed by the coordinator of elections reporting, at a minimum, the following information:
  - (1) The name of the event and the entity hosting or producing the event;
  - (2) The location and date of the event;
  - (3) The identity of the person or entity that paid for the attendance of the administrator of elections;
    - (4) Number of days attended; and
  - (5) The total amount of county, state, or federal funds used to attend the event, if any.
- (b) The administrator of elections shall file the form with the state election commission no later than fifteen (15) days after the date of the out-of-state training, seminar, conference, or other educational event related to elections.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
