AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 1, relative to performance measures.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-302(d)(2)(B)(iii), is amended by adding the following immediately after the existing language in the subdivision:

Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year, LEAs and public charter schools may also allow teachers to use the results from benchmark assessments including state-adopted benchmark assessments or a universal screener approved by the state board of education as a measure of student achievement.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
