AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 47, Chapter 18 and Title 53,
relative to foods that contain certain substances.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 53-1-102(14), is amended by
designating the existing language as subdivision (A) and adding the following as a new
subdivision (B):

(B) "Drug" also means food that contains a vaccine or vaccine material;


SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 53-1-102, is amended by adding the
following as a new subdivision:

() "Vaccine or vaccine material" means a substance intended for use in humans
to stimulate the production of antibodies and provide immunity against disease, prepared
from the causative agent of a disease, its products, or a synthetic substitute, treated to
act as an antigen without inducing the disease, that is authorized or approved by the
United States food and drug administration.


SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
