AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 33-1-401, relative to veteran representation on the statewide planning and policy council.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 33-1-401(b)(2), is amended by deleting the language:

Additionally, the commissioner of mental health and substance abuse services shall appoint one (1) representative for elderly service recipients and at least one (1) at-large representative.

and substituting instead:

Additionally, the commissioner of mental health and substance abuse services shall appoint one (1) representative for elderly service recipients, one (1) representative for military veteran recipients, and at least one (1) at-large representative.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


