AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 63 and Title 68, relative to the practice of pharmacy.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-10-204, is amended by deleting subdivision (38) and substituting:

(38) "Pharmacy technician" means an individual who is specifically trained and designated to assist a pharmacist and may perform tasks delegated by the pharmacist, including participation in drug, dietary supplement and device selection, storage, and distribution and administration, consistent with the pharmacy technician's education, training, and experience, as defined by rules promulgated by the board;

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
