AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-610, relative to nonredundant test items.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-610, is amended by deleting the second sentence in its entirety and substituting instead the following language:

Each year, at least thirty percent (30%) of items on each test must be fresh, nonredundant items that did not appear on that test in the previous two (2) years.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it, and shall apply to tests administered in the 2018-2019 school year and school years thereafter.
