AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 8; Title 33 and Title 63, Chapter 22, relative to therapists.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-22-103, is amended by deleting the section and substituting:


(a) The board shall license without examination a marital and family therapist applicant who is licensed to practice independently in another state if the applicant's qualifications meet the licensure requirements under this part.

(b) The board may enter into a reciprocal agreement with any other state that licenses marital and family therapists.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2024, the public welfare requiring it.
