## HOUSE BILL 2339

## AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 3, Part 6; Title 4, Chapter 6; Title 37; Title 38 and Title 41, relative to juveniles.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The department of correction, the Tennessee council of juvenile and family court judges, department of children's services, and state and local law enforcement agencies shall each submit a separate report to the general assembly listing all diversion and educational programs provided by the entity for justice-involved youth. The report must include program participation demographics and must be submitted to the general assembly by no later than July 1, 2024.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
