HOUSE BILL 2412

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4; Title 5; Title 6; Title 7; Title 12; Title 33; Title 39 and Title 71, relative to programs for the homeless.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE: SECTION 1.

- (a) The Tennessee advisory commission on intergovernmental relations (TACIR) is directed to perform a study of current programs in this state related to services provided to homeless persons for shelter, mental health, and safety, and to prepare a report comparing those programs and designating those programs with the highest success rates of helping individuals find employment and permanent shelter. The study must be conducted using TACIR's existing resources.
- (b) All appropriate state departments and agencies shall assist TACIR, upon request, in conducting the study described in subsection (a).
- (c) On or before January 1, 2023, TACIR shall report its findings and recommendations to each member of the general assembly and shall provide a copy of the report to the legislative librarian. The report may be delivered electronically.

 SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
