HOUSE BILL 2641

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 2, relative to voter registration.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-2-125, is amended by deleting subsections (a) and (b) and substituting instead the following:

- (a) If the administrator of elections determines that the registrant is not entitled to be registered, the administrator shall:
 - (1) Inform the registrant of the reason for the denial by:
 - (A) Telling the registrant, if the registrant is applying in person; or
 - (B) Mail, telephone call, and email within one hundred ten (110) days of the denial, if the registrant is applying online or by mail;
 - (2) Write the reason on the back of the original permanent registration record; and
 - (3) File the original and the duplicate alphabetically in a binder of rejected registrations.
- (b) The administrator shall inform the registrant that the registrant has a right to appeal the decision to the commission within ten (10) days of being informed of the denial and offer the registrant an appeal form.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020, the public welfare requiring it.
